



Paint Your Own Porcelain

- Prepare Your Work Area

- 1. Wash all porcelain pieces with soap and water. Let each piece dry thoroughly.
- 2. Stir each paint pot to mix the paint prior to use. If the paint appears to be too thick, add a few drops of water and mix thoroughly.

IMPORTANT

ADULT SUPERVISION IS RECOMMENDED. USE A CONVENTIONAL GAS OR ELECTRIC OVEN. DO NOT USE A MICROWAVE.

Do not use a microwave oven to bake the porcelain.

Do not touch the porcelain right after baking.

The porcelain is EXTREMELY HOT.

Wash thoroughly before and after use. Hand wash only.

- 1. To achieve the best results and brightest paint colors, allow the painted porcelain 24 hours drying time.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 225°F / 110°C.
- 3. Set the painted porcelain on a baking sheet and carefully place it in the oven.
- 4. Bake the porcelain in the oven for 30 minutes.
- 5. After 30 minutes, turn the oven off. The porcelain will be very hot. Let the porcelain cool in the oven prior to removal.





To prevent the paints from drying out, open only one color at a time.

Clean your brush in water prior to dipping the brush in another paint color.

Wait until the first coat of paint is dry to the touch before applying a second coat or another color.
